2. TECHNICAL PROFICIENCY - CONNOTES SUBJECT ACTIVITY DESIGNED TO PROVIDE THE CANDIDATE WITH SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO UNDERTAKE FURTHER STUDY OR TRAINING OR TO BE EMPLOYED AT THE PRE-TECHNICIAN LEVEL.

- GRADE ONE - CANDIDATE SHOWS A *COMPREHENSIVE* GRASP OF THE KEY CONCEPTS, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES REQUIRED BY THE SYLLABUS.

- GRADE SIX - CANDIDATE SHOWS A *VERY LIMITED* GRASP OF THE KEY CONCEPTS, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES REQUIRED BY THE SYLLABUS.
